Why have the roof repairs been started ? Has the parish already raised enough money?

The money has not been raised, but we have faith the Sacred Heart community will support this effort. We needed to take advantage of the opportunity provided by the mild weather and the opening in the contractors' schedules to get the roof repairs done. Completing the work now also prevents any further damage which might result in higher costs.

Will any of the money raised be shared with the Diocese of Saginaw?

No monies from important projects like these at Sacred Heart —or any Sunday giving dollars, for that matter—are shared with the Diocese. The only money which is shared with the Diocese is Catholic Services Appeal (CSA) money. Thanks to the generosity of our members, Sacred Heart has already met our CSA goal this year. “Dwelling Place” dollars stay local, and will be used on the projects outlined in Father Loren’s request packet.

Who should give to this campaign?

Everyone’s help is needed. Individuals, couples, families—we need contributions from all sources in our parish. Members and friends who own businesses can also help by making a corporate donation.
