Welcome supporters of Catholic School Education at Sacred Heart Academy:

We are celebrating our 29<sup>th</sup> SHAgala event to raise funds for our Academy and to help make Catholic education affordable for all students. This event is the biggest and largest event. Last year, we netted just a little over \$364,000, the most money SHAgala has ever accumulated in its history.

Our theme for this year is "Derby Party". When I think of Derby Party, the Kentucky Derby race comes to mind. The inaugural race of the Derby was run in 1875, just a few years before our school opened in 1889. The winner of that first race was Aristides in 2:37.75, the winning jockey was Oliver Lewis, and the trainer was Ansel Williamson.

The Kentucky Derby is held each year on the first Saturday of the month of May and is also known as "The Run for The Roses". A lush blanket of 554 red roses is awarded to the Derby Winner. This tradition originated in 1883 when E. Berry Wall presented roses to ladies at a post derby party. The Governor of Kentucky presents the garland of roses to the winning horse as well as the trophy. The song, "My Old Kentucky Home", is always played by the University of Louisville Band during the horses parade to the Call To The Post. People come from all over the world to watch this big event.

The largest crowd was in 2017 when 158,070 people attended. Among the wellknown traditions associated with the Derby are women appearing in elegant outfits wearing large flowery, elegant hats. Many patrons sip on mint juleps, an iced drink consisting of bourbon, mint, and sugar syrup. This is the official beverage of the race.

Just like the Derby is the most exciting and well-attended event of Kentucky, so our SHAgala is the most exciting and largest event of Mt. Pleasant, Michigan. Our gymnasiums are filled with all kinds of items, clothing, sportswear, packages, vacation trips, golf destinations, jewelry, and assorted other gifts. There is something for everyone, either in the silent or live auctions.

Special thanks to all our volunteers, to our school personnel, our parents, teachers, students, and all who have donated time, talent, and resources to make this a successful Derby Party.



The Run For The Roses

### 12 Fun Facts About The Kentucky Derby

#### 1. It's the Longest-Running Sporting Event in the U.S.

The Kentucky Derby has the longest history of any sporting event in the country. The first race was May 17, 1875, with 15 horses competing in front of a crowd of about 10,000.

#### 2. The Trophy Is Made of Real Gold.

The Kentucky Derby trophy is smaller than you might think: It's 22 inches tall and only weighs 3.5 pounds, despite being made from 14-karat gold and perched on a jade base.

#### 3. The Derby Has an Official Cocktail.

The official drink of the Kentucky Derby is the mint julep. More than 120,000 of the cocktails are served each year at the Kentucky Derby (the venue needs more than 1,000 pounds of fresh mint to meet that demand.)

#### 4. This Will Be the 149th Year of the Derby.

2023 marks the 149th consecutive year of the horse race. While the event hasn't always been held on the first Saturday of May each year (it's been postponed a few times), there has always been a Kentucky Derby held each calendar year.

#### 5. The Hats Weren't Always a Tradition.

The Kentucky Derby is known for fashion just as much as it's known for horse racing. For decades, women have worn big, elaborate hats to watch the race but that wasn't always the case. Hats didn't become a popular accessory at the Derby until the mid-1960s when the event (and the spectators) began to be televised. Around that time, women began wearing fancier clothing and extravagant hats in hopes that they'd be seen on television.

#### 6. The Race Has an Official Flower.

The official flower of the Kentucky Derby is a red rose. Each year, the winner is crowned with a garland of red roses, leading some to call the event 'The Run for the Roses.'

#### 7. The Rose Garland Weighs More Than 40 Pounds.

The famous rose garland that is draped over the winning horse is made with more than 400 red roses, which are sewn together on green satin. The garland weighs about 40 pounds—that's a lot of flowers!

#### 8. It's Called "The Most Exciting Two Minutes in Sports".

For all the hype surrounding it, the actual race only lasts about two minutes—which is why it's been dubbed, "the most exciting two minutes in sports." Blink, and you'd miss it!

#### 9. Only 3-Year-Old Horses Can Compete.

Not just any horse can compete in the Derby! Only 3-year-old horses are allowed to race, which means each horse will compete only one time.

#### 10. The Derby's First Winner Was Named Aristides.

A chestnut thoroughbred named Aristides was the winner of the very first Kentucky Derby in 1875. He finished the race in two minutes and 37 seconds, beating 14 other horses. The fastest Kentucky Derby was run by Secretariat in 1973 (1:59.40). The slowest winning time was run by Kingman in 1891 (2:52.25 for the mile and a half. Note: In 1896 the Derby was shortened to one and one-quarter mile because the mile and a half length was believed to be too long for three-year old horses to run in the Spring).

#### 11. The Derby Has Been Postponed Just Twice.

The Derby is always held on the first Saturday in May—except for the two years it was postponed: once in 1945 due to World War II, and again in 2020 because of the COVID-19 pandemic.

#### 12. The Derby Is Connected to Lewis & Clark.

The Kentucky Derby was started in 1946 by Lewis Clark Jr., the grandson of William Clark. Lewis Clark Jr. had seen the Epsom Derby in England and wanted to bring the tradition to the United States.


